This is a PURCHASE OF SERVICE AGREEMENT between ECHO HILL OUTDOOR SCHOOL, INC., (hereinafter referred to as "OUTDOOR SCHOOL") and Montessori International Children's House (M.I.C.H.) (hereinafter referred to as "PARTICIPATING SCHOOL"), located at 1641 Winchester Road, Annapolis, MD 21409 and telephone number 410-757-7789.

1. Dates of Attendance will be: September 29 - October, 2021
- a. Arrival Time: 11:30 A.M.
 - b. Departure Day: Lunch 12:00 P.M. Departure 1:00 P.M.
[If an earlier departure is required, a bag lunch will be provided.]
 - c. Number of Students: ~~18~~ 16 (7 boys) (9 girls)
 - d. Number of Teachers: 2-3 1-2
 - e. Teachers' Names: Overnight
 - f. Grade: 4th - 6th

2. Outdoor School agrees to provide food, cooking services, facilities, housing, administrative oversight, teacher naturalists, accident-illness student insurance and an appropriate outdoor education program. Total costs will be \$ 309.00 per student for the specified period. The Participating School may bring two teacher/adult chaperones without charge. The Participating School will be charged \$ 92.00 for each additional teacher/adult chaperone.

3. The Participating School agrees to provide:
- a. Transportation to and from Outdoor School.
 - b. A completed and signed medical form (to be supplied in blank by Outdoor School) for each child in attendance.
 - c. At least one teacher/adult chaperone to accompany the group and to be in residence for the specified period.
 - d. A list of all students attending. The students in the list should be divided into groups or tribes for classes and into tent groups. Outdoor School must receive this list at least one week before arrival.

4. The Participating School further agrees:
- a. To pay Outdoor School a non-refundable deposit of 30% (thirty percent) of the total due on or before July 8, 2021.
 - b. To pay Outdoor School the balance of the fee no later than one week before arrival.
 - c. To assume full and sole responsibility to inform student's family or guardian that the participating student's primary health insurance carrier will assume expenses for injuries that occur during the program. The Outdoor School agrees to pay for any expenses that are not covered by the primary insurance (co-pays, co-insurance, deductibles, etc) up to a maximum of \$25,000 for injuries.
 - d. To provide in writing any information concerning any child's inability to participate in our normal educational and camping activities.
 - e. To execute and return the attached Guarantee (Attachment A).
 - f. To provide the information and non-discrimination statement requested in the Certification (Attachment B).
